









The largest and best in Mato Grosso do Sul, UFMS takes pride in being a public, free, inclusive, and high-quality university, with more than 40,000 students. 



Symbolic Monument: The Dynamism of Youth

Built in 1970, at the entrance of the University City in Campo Grande, the Symbolic Monument of UFMS, affectionately nicknamed "Paliteiro" (Toothpick Holder), is a project by architect Caetano Francarolli, who was inspired by youth. The work consists of a set of 24 horizontal columns rising from the water, symbolizing life and offering a sense of movement, expressing the dynamism of youth. The columns, directed upwards, pointing to infinity, represent the boundless eagerness of the young people of our land.

Integrative Monument: Sou UFMS

The "Sou UFMS" sign, installed in 2019, encourages a sense of belonging and pride in being UFMS across all campuses, as well as reinforcing the university's visual identity and serving as a perfect location for photographs.








The first step has already been taken just by being here, and this journey will be full of moments only you can experience. Now that you know how to get around the campuses, it's time to explore university life. Get ready to use your skills, learn shortcuts, and, most importantly, enjoy every phase of this unique experience!

Academic Secretariat

The Academic Secretariat oversees and executes all activities related to undergraduate courses and is responsible for issuing documents such as Academic Transcripts, Enrollment Certificates, among others. They are present in all Academic Units and also operate online 24 hours a day.

Documents can be requested in person or issued electronically through the Academic System (Siscad) or the Post-Graduation page.

Through the apps "Sou UFMS" and "Sou UFMS Pós", available on PlayStore and Apple Store, undergraduate students can also view class schedules, attendance, and grades; access Student Identity, search the bibliographic collection; activate the UFMS Alert button; and track in real-time the internal shuttle bus route of the University City, the Capi Shuttle.

RGA

The Academic Registration Number (RGA) is the identification code you receive when you enroll.

In the UFMS World, you can't enter without your UFMS Passport

The UFMS Passport manages your access to computers and all the University systems. It is composed of a personal login and password, meaning it is unique and non-transferable. It is necessary to use the Wi-Fi network and to fill out any academic request.

UFMS ID

The Student ID proves that you are a student here and grants access to University spaces, the library collection, university restaurants, and gives you half-price entry, when available, to shows, cinemas, and cultural events.

The ID card is virtual for all undergraduate and graduate students with an active RGA. It is a personal and non-transferable document.

What is Siscad?

It is the system for control, registration, monitoring, and dissemination of academic information. Here, you can check attendance, grades, and access course syllabi. It is recommended to access it at least once a week.

What is Sigpós?

It is an automated system for control, registration, monitoring, and dissemination of UFMS post-graduation programs. In it, you can track attendance, grades, and access syllabi.

What is AVA UFMS?

The Virtual Learning Environment is your digital space to study, interact, and grow academically, whether in an on-campus or distance course. Here, you access course content, exchange ideas with colleagues, talk to professors and tutors, and complete activities and assessments.

Enrollments Always Online!

Enrollment establishes the academic bond between a student and a UFMS undergraduate or graduate program. The first enrollment and renewal (starting from the second semester) are done online.

Enrollment renewal is done every semester through the Academic System (Siscad) at siscad.ufms.br, according to the UFMS academic calendar. This process occurs in four stages:

- 1. Select subjects online;
- 2. The course coordination checks your enrollment and makes adjustments for any issues from the subject selection stage;
- 3. You have the opportunity to make adjustments to your enrollment after the course coordination has made its adjustments;
- 4. Finally, the Academic Secretariat validates and confirms your enrollment in Siscad.



In the UFMS World, You Can Use Your Social Name!

A social name is the way people are recognized, identified, and named within their community and social environment, which may not correspond to their civil name.

Students can request the inclusion of their social name at the time of enrollment or at any time via an Academic Request. For minors under 18 years old, the inclusion of a social name must be requested with parental or legal guardian authorization.

UFMS Passport is your key to accessing various university systems, including AVA UFMS, institutional email, Siscad, Sigpos, Sigproj, the Sou UFMS app, the Digital Library, and more!

How to create your UFMS Passport?

- 1. Access: passaporte.ufms.br
- 2. Enter your CPF (taxpayer identification number) and date of birth
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the registration
- 4. Create a secure password and you're done!

Rules of the game

Now that you are immersed in the UFMS World, it's time to understand the basic rules to ensure your journey is a success. Don't worry, there aren't many, and you'll learn them quickly!

UFMS has a set of rules to ensure organization, harmony, and respect within the university environment. Students should follow these principles both in-person and online:

- Kindness in all interactions at the University, with courtesy, respect, education, and consideration for others.
- · Promotion and defense of human dignity;
- Striving for and promoting equity;
- Solidarity;
- · No discrimination of any kind;
- Social integration and responsibility;
- · Defense of peace;
- Caring for UFMS's image;
- · Pluralism of ideas, beliefs, and viewpoints.

We know you won't need this, but just so you know: The Ombudsman and the Inspector General's Office (Ouvidoria e Corregedoria) are units responsible for maintaining integrity, transparency, and access to information at the University.

The Inspector General's Office, created and implemented in 2020, aims to promote and preserve integrity, ethics, and morality in administrative actions by coordinating, planning, and organizing UFMS's investigative activities. It is responsible for initiating and conducting investigations and determining disciplinary actions.

The Ombudsman is here to help you communicate with UFMS units. You can share compliments, suggestions, complaints, reports, and requests for access to information. To do so, visit: ouvidoria.ufms.br.

Always remember: before contacting the Ombudsman, there are closer internal bodies, such as the Course Coordination, the Academic Secretariat



UFMS promotes a safe and respectful environment for its community. The UFMS Policy for Prevention and Combat of Moral and Sexual Harassment aims to prevent and eliminate violence and disrespect, ensuring that students and staff can thrive freely. If you witness or are a victim of such behavior, familiarize yourself with the reporting and support channels. The Ombudsman provides a complaint manual to ensure your voice is heard. or the Management of your unit, who are available to support you in your academic journey. If you cannot resolve your issue with them or if you wish to submit a compliment or report, the Ombudsman is ready to listen and assist you.

Our University also has the Women's Ombudsman, linked to the Sou Mulher UFMS Program and the Policy for Prevention and Combat of Moral and Sexual Harassment, to support women who are victims of violence and promote the guidance and confidentiality of reports received.

What if you get sick or have a baby?

In the Special Regime, you can carry out your academic activities at home, hospital, or school, for the following reasons:

- Illness, infection, trauma, or another health condition preventing attendance for more than seven days and up to sixty consecutive days.
- Being pregnant, starting from the eighth month of pregnancy or after childbirth, for up to 180 days, except in high-risk pregnancies, which may have an extended period. The adoptive mother can also request the Special Regime.



- Being a father, starting from the first working day after the birth of the child, for up to twenty days.
- Being part of a high-risk group in the case of an international health emergency.

Can you request a review of your grades?

Students have the right to request a review of their grades within ten calendar days after the grade is published on Siscad. The review request must be directed to the professor in the first instance through a specific request.

What to do if you disagree with the grade correction?

Students may request a review of their grades within ten calendar days after the grades are published on Siscad, addressed to the professor in the first instance.

HOW TO PASS A COURSE

Undergraduate

Students will be considered approved if they have a minimum attendance of 75% and an Average Performance (AP) equal to or higher than 6.0.

Postgraduate

The final performance will be expressed with grades A, B, C, and D, with D considered insufficient for approval.

Attendance

A student who does not achieve at least 75% attendance in the classes of a subject and/or participation in activities outlined in the Syllabus will be failed due to absences. In specific cases, it may be possible to compensate for missed classes, such as:

- Court summons:
- · Participation in UFMS Collegiate Board meetings as a member;
- Participation in official sports, arts, and cultural activities representing UFMS;
- Presentation of studies at technical-scientific events representing UFMS;
- Enrollment in a course or subjects up to 45 calendar days after the beginning of the semester.

What if you notice an error in the attendance record?

Students have the right to request a review of their attendance within ten calendar days after the attendance is posted in Siscad. The request must be addressed to the professor and specify which classes were wrongly marked as absences.

Exame Nacional de Desempenho de Estudantes (Enade)

The Enade is a test administered by the Ministry of Education at the end of each year to assess the performance of students completing a selected group of courses. The exam is mandatory, as the results are part of a set of indicators used to evaluate the quality of higher education in Brazil.

Every year, the Institutional Evaluation Directorate organizes a series of lectures and discussion rounds to prepare and sensitize students from all campuses, as well as provide support at the exam locations.



How to create your Digital Student ID?

- 1. Visit proaes.ufms.br/identidade/identidade-estudantilla-via and check your personal information.
 - 2. Upload a photo and submit the form. Wait up to three business days for photo approval.
- 3. Download the "Sou UFMS" or "Sou UFMS Pós" app from the Play Store or Apple Store and log in using your UFMS Passport.
 - 4. In the app menu, access the Student ID option.
- 5. Confirm your information, and voilà! Your digital ID will be available on your screen.

Now, you have your official student identification from UFMS always at hand!

Libraries



UFMS libraries are freely accessible to the entire community via UFMS Passport. They house one of the largest physical collections in the state: over 490,000 physical and digital books, thousands of scientific journals, theses, and dissertations to support teaching, research, and extension activities. The "Minha Biblioteca" platform offers digital titles with an emphasis on Medicine, Health, Exact Sciences, Law, Social Sciences, Arts, and Humanities. The Pearson Virtual Library also offers digital technical, scientific, and academic books in over 40 areas of knowledge. Access to digital books from these platforms is available through the online catalog Pergamum, using the same login and password as for borrowing materials.

Success and quality of life in studies

To ensure that undergraduate students can thrive in university life, UFMS offers financial aid aimed at students facing socio-economic vulnerability. To apply, the student must prove, through the Unique Registration (Cadastro Único), a family income of up to one minimum wage per person. In addition, all campuses of the university have support teams, including translators and interpreters of Brazilian Sign Language (Libras), psychologists, and social workers for the assistance of undergraduate and graduate students.

The Dean of Student Affairs (Proaes) is responsible for integration actions, social services, and health and well-being promotion for students. To support everyone, Proaes works with the secretariats and student support sectors, which provide direct assistance to students at each campus.

Permanence Aid

Helps with the basic expenses of students in undergraduate programs during their time at the university.

Green Room

Anatomy Museum

Located in Sector 3 of the University City, near the Lago do Amor, the Anatomy Museum displays the UFMS anatomical collection for both the internal and external communities, with the aim of popularizing science and sparking curiosity among the population.





Moreninho Gymnasium

Inaugurated in 1976 and located in the University City, the Eric Tinoco Marques Sports Gymnasium, also known as Moreninho, is a key space for sports practice at UFMS. In addition to classes for students from the Faculty of Education and training for sports teams, the gymnasium hosts events such as the Integra UFMS, the Fetec MS (Fair of Technologies, Engineering, and Sciences of Mato Grosso do Sul), graduations, and exhibitions.

Morenão Stadium

Inaugurated on March 7, 1971, the Pedro Pedrossian Stadium, also known as Morenão, is a cultural and sports heritage of Mato Grosso do Sul society. Designed by architects Avedis Balabanian and Ciríaco Maymone, the stadium spans approximately 50,000 square meters and has a capacity of 30,000 people, making it the largest university stadium in the country.





To promote sports practices across the University City and the campuses, UFMS offers aquatic complexes with swimming pools, various courts, outdoor gyms, and the Academic Fitness Center.

Internship

Internships are activities developed by students to complement their learning by experiencing classroom content in the workplace, either in public and private institutions or under the guidance of professionals. 

Integrated School Clinic:

Available at the University City, Coxim and Três Lagoas campuses, the UFMS Integrated School Clinic provides free health care to students, staff, and the general public. It also fosters collaboration between the courses of Nursing, Physiotherapy, and Nutrition through teaching, research, and extension activities.

Dental Clinic

A state reference, the UFMS Faculty of Dentistry offers various dental services as part of its students' training, such as dental fillings, surgeries, endodontics, prosthetics, and oral pathology. It also offers specialized care for babies, pediatric dentistry, and treatment for individuals with special needs.

Language Courses:

UFMS offers foreign language programs at all campuses. The "Idiomas Sem Fronteiras" (Languages Without Borders) Program, supported by the Ministry of Education, offers free proficiency and level testing, as well as online and in-person language courses for the university community. With an extensive collection, UFMS Publishing House focuses on publishing the university's knowledge, including books, conference proceedings, and journals, both printed and digital. Interested individuals can access free e-books in the Institutional Repository or purchase works at the "Ponto de Conexão Científica" (Scientific Connection Point) located at the Central Corridor of the University City Campus.

Dance School

The extension project "Dança de Salão" (Ballroom dance) offers lessons in various musical rhythms, taught by students under the supervision of university professors. Interested people can register for beginner and advanced classes. For more information, visit dancadesalao.ufms.br.

The Sinapse Contemporary Dance Company of UFMS, created in 2019, focuses on artistic production based on practical and theoretical studies related to dance. Auditions are required to join.

Music School

The Music School offers collective lessons in instruments, singing, music theory, and children's musicalization at an affordable price for students, faculty, staff, collaborators, and the general community. Activities are taught by faculty and students of the Music Education program.

UFMS Symphony Group

Initially created to complement the activities of Music Education students at UFMS, the orchestra provides continuous training for brass and percussion instrumentalists in the local community. Over time, it evolved into the UFMS Symphony Group, supporting music diffusion, concerts, video productions, and symphonic group maintenance. Interested individuals can join the Experimental Community Band and Orchestra through auditions.

Student Legal Assistance Office (EMAJ)

Through a humanized legal culture, the Student Legal Assistance Office (EMAJ) offers sensitive training for UFMS Law students. With units at the University City, Coxim, Três Lagoas, and Pantanal campuses, EMAJ provides both in-person and online legal assistance, bridging theory and practice through educational, pedagogical, social, cultural, and scientific activities.





Pharmacy School

The UFMS Pharmacy School provides free health care to the public, focusing on maintaining health and quality of life. Services include specialized care for patients with multiple sclerosis, asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, and systemic sclerosis at the Hospital Universitário Maria Aparecida Pedrossian (Humap-UFMS/Ebserh) outpatient clinic. Pharmacists also offer patient follow-up, medication guidance, and health-related problem identification, including blood pressure measurement, bioimpedance, capillary glucose measurement, and peak expiratory flow measurement.

Computer Labs

All UFMS campuses are equipped with spaces containing computers and internet access for students, available both during classes and outside of them.

UFMS Bookstore

In addition to selling books, the UFMS Bookstore also offers stationery products and UFMS-branded items such as hats, t-shirts, mugs, and stickers, with various payment options. At the University City Campus, those interested should visit the "Ponto de Conexão Científica," located in the Central Corridor.



School Market



Located next to the Moreninho Gym, UFMS's School Market serves as a center for the study and commercialization of organic and agroecological products from family farming in Mato Grosso do Sul. The facility includes laboratories and rooms for training and guidance on good practices, as well as a covered outdoor patio.

Pantanal Mixed Business Incubator (PIME)

With units at all campuses, the Pantanal Mixed Business Incubator (PIME) facilitates the generation and consolidation of innovative ventures and supports the development of new businesses and the training of potential entrepreneurs in Mato Grosso do Sul.

Psychology School Service

UFMS offers free psychological counseling for the university community and the general public at the University City, Paranaíba and Pantanal campuses. These services are provided by students under the supervision of professors.



Security

All campuses are equipped with ecotechnological bus stops powered by renewable energy, which include smart lighting sensors, USB charging displays, the UFMS Alert Button (which directly connects to university security), and speakers tuned to the UFMS Educational Radio 99.9 FM at the University City Campus. To enhance the protection of the university community, facial recognition cameras and mobile security monitoring have also been installed.

UFMS Alert Button

Developed by the UFMS Agency of Information and Communication Technology (Agetic), the system records incidents and situations reported by the university community and automatically alerts the security team with the location of the occurrence. The UFMS Alert Button is installed at the ecotechnological bus stops and accessible bathrooms, and is also available in the "Sou UFMS" app.
